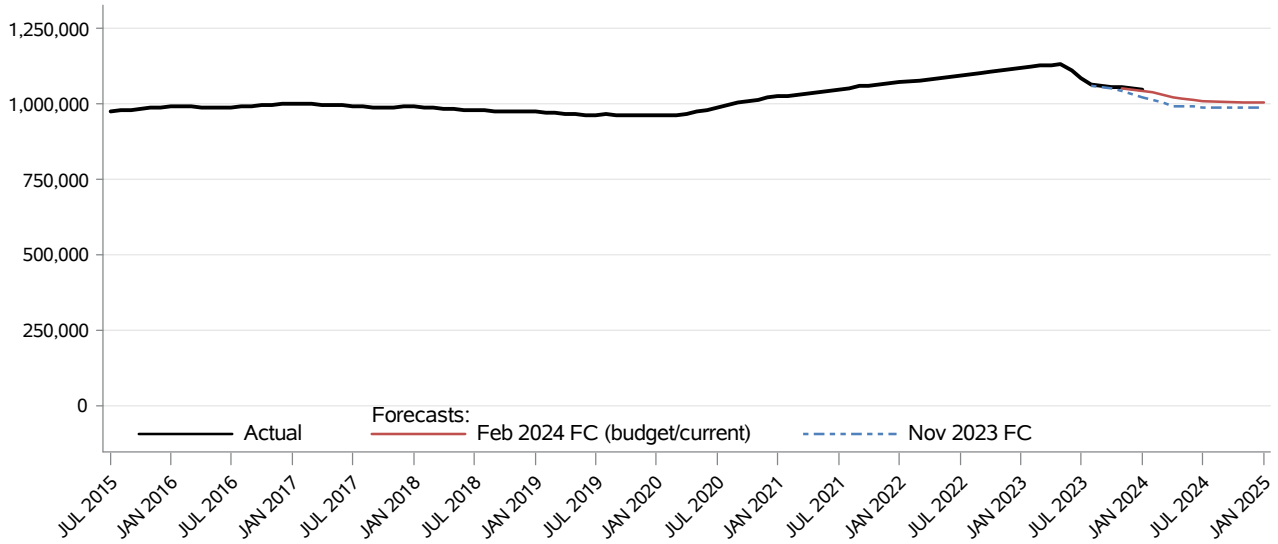


Medical Services Total Adult Caretakers and Children
