# STATISTICAL SUMMARY OF ADULT FELONY SENTENCING

## Fiscal Year 1999

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## **PREFACE**

This report summarizes data on adult felony sentences in Washington State for the period of July 1, 1998 through June 30, 1999 (FY1999). There were 24,391 felony sentences imposed in FY1999, representing a one percent increase from the number of sentences imposed in FY1998.

The sentences summarized in this report were imposed for crimes committed on or after July 1, 1984. Adult felony crimes committed after that date were sentenced under the Sentencing Reform Act (SRA) of 1981, as amended, Chapter 9.94A RCW.

Under the SRA, every felony offense has a standard (presumptive) sentence range that is determined according to the seriousness of the current offense and the number and type of the offender's prior and other current offenses. In most cases, an offender will receive a sentence within the standard range for that offense. In five percent of felony cases, offenders are given "exceptional" sentences that fall outside the standard sentence range.

A sentencing judge may order an exceptional sentence outside the standard range if there are substantial and compelling reasons (either aggravating or mitigating factors) to do so. These reasons must be documented in writing. An exceptional sentence may be appealed by the defense or by the prosecution; standard range sentences may not be appealed. Occasionally, an exceptional sentence is imposed that does not result in confinement outside the standard range. Such a sentence may be used, for example, to require community supervision exceeding the standard range sentence, or to require treatment in situations where the standard sentence does not provide for it.

The length of confinement may be reduced up to one-third for good behavior, but may not be extended. Beginning with offenses committed on or after July 1, 1990, offenders convicted of serious violent offenses or Class A sex offenses may only receive an earned early release of up to 15 percent of the sentence. New offenses require new convictions before additional penalties may be imposed, although up to 60 days of jail may be ordered for violations of sentence conditions.

Alternatives to the standard range sentence are available for some eligible offenders. Nonviolent offenders who have no prior felony convictions and who are not being sentenced for a sex offense or certain drug offenses may have the standard sentence waived. This alternative, called the First-time Offender Waiver (FTOW), allows the sentencing judge to impose up to 90 days in jail, two years of community supervision and several conditions, such as maintaining employment or receiving treatment.

Sex offenders who have no prior felony sex convictions may receive a sentence under the Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative (SSOSA) if they are not convicted of a serious violent offense with a sexual motivation finding or of Rape 1, Attempted Rape 1 or Rape 2, and have a current offense and criminal history that permits the court to impose a sentence within the standard range of less than eleven years confinement. A person sentenced under SSOSA receives a suspended sentence within the standard range, a jail term of up to six months, and several conditions of sentence that may include inpatient and/or outpatient treatment. For offenses committed after June 30, 1990, SSOSA offenders receive three years of community custody or up to the length of the suspended sentence, if that is over three years.

The Drug Offender Sentencing Alternative (DOSA) allows for a reduction in confinement time for eligible offenders, combined with intensive treatment while in confinement and also during supervision in the community. Offenders sentenced on or after April 19, 1995 for Manufacture, Delivery or Possession with Intent to Manufacture or Deliver a Schedule I or II Narcotic (Heroin or Cocaine), or for attempt, solicitation or conspiracy to commit such an offense, are eligible for DOSA. A court electing the DOSA option imposes a sentence of one-half of the midpoint of the presumptive standard range for the offense, to be served in a prison facility. The court must also impose a one-year period of supervision in the community, which must include substance abuse treatment, crime-related prohibitions and testing and monitoring for drug use. Eligibility for the DOSA program was expanded by the 1999 Legislature, but the data in this report reflect only those sentences imposed prior to the effective date of the 1999 DOSA amendments.

The tables in this report were generated from the Commission's database, which includes data on SRA offenders sentenced on or after January 1, 1985. The Commission invites any comments or questions the reader may have:

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## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- In FY99, the total number of felony sentences imposed in Washington State rose to 24,391, only a one percent increase from 24,145 in FY98.
- As compared with FY98, the most significant change in sentences imposed was a 9.6 percent decrease in murder sentences. There were slight increases in the number of sentences imposed for robbery and for drug offenses, but the number of sentences imposed for most crime types remained almost unchanged from FY98:

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+ 4.4% Robbery (from 643 to 671)
- 9.6% Murder (from 156 to 141)
+ 1.1% Manslaughter (from 93 to 94)
+ 0.3% Assault (from 3,505 to 3,514)
- 0.9% Property (from 8,564 to 8,487)
+ 3.2% Drugs (from 7,855 to 8,105)
+ 0.2% Sex (from 1,122 to 1,124)

- In FY99, 29.1 percent of all sentences resulted in a prison sentence, almost unchanged from 29.4 percent in FY98.
- The average sentence length decreased from 15.4 months in FY98 to 14.7 months in FY99. This change was due to a decrease in the average length of prison sentences. Average jail sentences increased only slightly, from 2.7 months in FY98 to 2.8 months in FY99.
- In FY99, sentences for violations of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act (VUCSA) increased by 3.2 percent over VUCSA sentences in the previous year. Sentences for "non-dealing" VUCSA offenses increased, rising by 7.4 percent; sentences for "dealing" offenses actually decreased by 3.9 percent.
- In FY99, 23 offenders were sentenced to life in prison as persistent offenders under the "three strikes" provision of Initiative 593. Four sex offenders were sentenced to life in prison in FY99 under the "two-strike" provision of Initiative 593. The 27 new persistent offenders sentenced to life in prison in FY99 was the same number as in FY98.
- The number First-time Offender Waivers (FTOW) granted decreased from 3,051 in FY98 to 2,898 in FY99, a 5 percent decrease. Approximately 21 percent of the FTOW sentences were below the standard range minimum, while the remainder included sentences within or above the standard range.
- The number of offenders receiving a Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative (SSOSA) increased by 8.3 percent, from 205 in FY98 to 222 in FY99.

#### **EXCEPTIONAL SENTENCES**

Under provisions of the Sentencing Reform Act (SRA), every adult felony offense has a presumed range of punishment determined by the seriousness of the offense, by the number and type of other current offenses and by the number and type of prior adult and juvenile offenses. The presumptive range for certain offenses may be increased for weapon usage, for dealing drugs in a school or other protected zone or for certain drug offenses committed in a correctional facility. The presumptive range is decreased by 25 percent if the current offense is an attempt, conspiracy or solicitation to commit a felony. Some alternative sentences are possible under the First-time Offender Waiver (FTOW) for first time offenders, excluding violent, sex or certain drug offenders. In addition, the Special Sex Offender Sentencing Alternative (SSOSA) allows suspended sentences for certain offenders, and the Drug Offender Sentencing Alternative (DOSA) allows for reduced confinement time for eligible offenders.

The SRA presumes that, in most cases, a sentencing judge will impose a sentence within the standard range for the offense. An exceptional sentence is a sentence outside the standard range. (Alternative sentences under FTOW, SSOSA or DOSA are not considered exceptional sentences.) An exceptional sentence is allowed if there are substantial and compelling reasons supported by the record. The judge is required to record these reasons in writing. Some exceptional sentences do not result in incarceration outside the standard range, but are used to provide sentence conditions not otherwise permitted (*e.g.*, lengthy community supervision). Exceptional sentences may be appealed by the prosecution or the defense.

The following tables summarize the reasons recorded by sentencing judges when imposing exceptional sentences. Reasons are summarized separately for mitigated sentences, aggravated sentences and sentences within the standard range.
