
Department of Revenue Working Families' Tax Credit (WFTC)

The Department of Revenue (DOR) **Working Families' Tax Credit** (WFTC) caseload is the number of low income households who receive a tax refund for sales tax spent in the previous tax year. The refund returns a portion of sales tax paid each year and is modeled after the federal Earned Income Tax Credit program.
