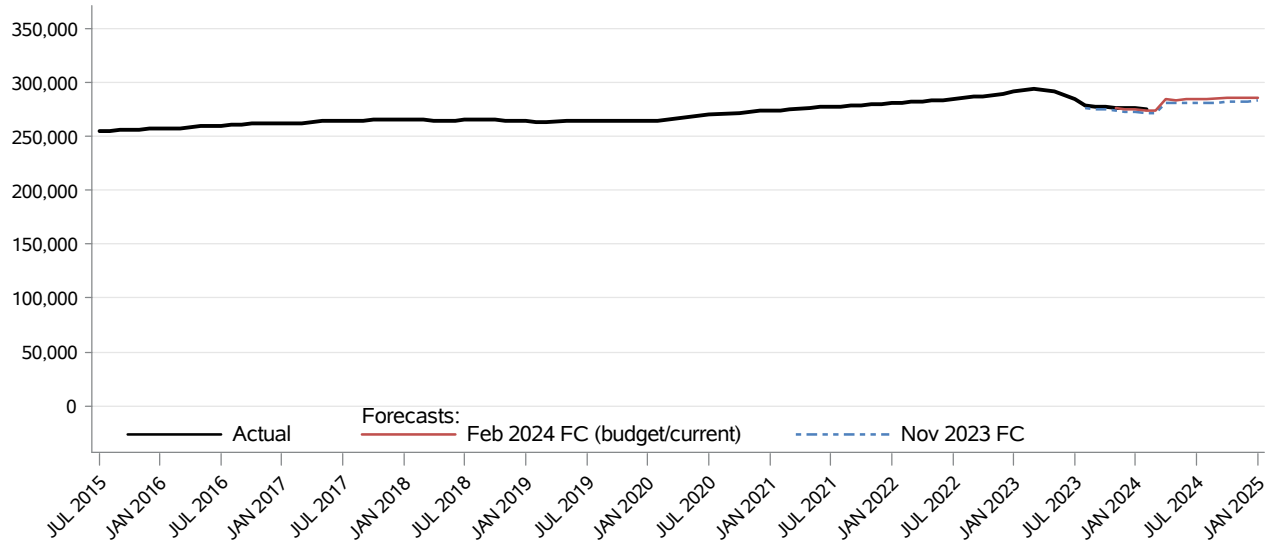


Medical Services Total Aged, Blind and People with Disabilities CFC Monthly Monitoring Report
